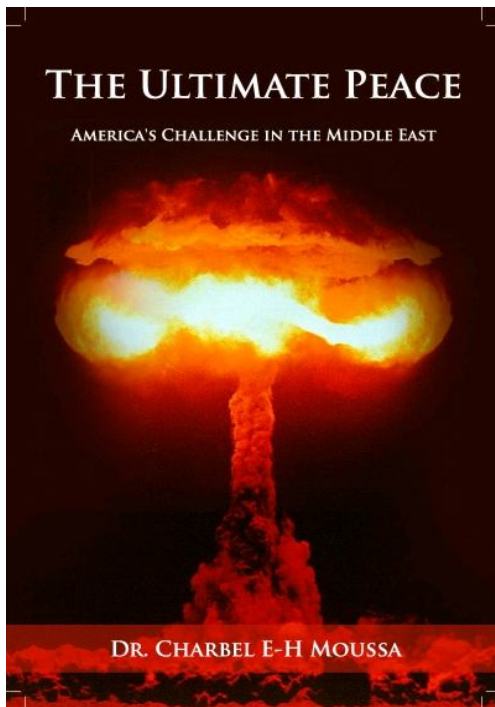


The Ultimate Peace: America's Challenge in the Middle East

The Ultimate Peace by Dr. Moussa envisages socio-political, ethno-religious and strategic issues that engender conflict and peace in the Middle East. This book is a thorough account of the deep-rooted struggle between Sunni and Shiite Muslims and how it affects Middle East stability and U.S. policies. The current political and strategic alignments are greatly influenced by the rise of the Islamic Republic of Iran as a regional power following the tragedies of 9/11 and the U.S. invasion of Iraq. Iran's nuclear ambition has several repercussions on the Middle East, the US and the world. Nuclear Iran is a direct threat of forceful Islamic expansionism into the Middle East, primarily Israel. Iran undoubtedly aims at eliminating Israel from Middle Eastern strategic and political existence. Non-Muslim minority groups in the Middle East and the domination of Sunni Muslims over Islam strategically hinder the Shiite Iranian ideology of "Islamization". The goal of "Islamic" Iran is to gain international recognition and fear from its neighbors in order to stand at the helm of the Islamic world and challenge the Judeo-Christian traditions of the West.

He is also the author of "From Wars to Peace: Lebanon in a Mediterranean System" and "Lebanon in the New World." He also published dozens of medical and political articles in top internationally recognized journals. He is currently an Assistant Professor at Georgetown University and lives with his wife Dina, in the Washington D.C. area.



The ramifications of the Iranian dilemma are exacerbated by a journalistic style of Western diplomacy and corporate journalism that lead to public frustration. The U.S. can protect American interests and promote peace via a gradual and long-term strategic architecture of regional inter-locking institutions that comprise a "New Mediterranean". A change in the style of U.S. diplomacy, the righteous fear of Iran's nuclear weapons and the respect of the evolution of local democracies can collectively contribute to "The Ultimate Peace".
